- Helping with in-home services, daily chores, and personal care.
- Making available an extensive lending closet.
- Offering social and educational outings.
- Sponsoring games and art classes.
- Fostering friendship.
- And providing “just a fun place.”



Our mission is to help keep Sublette County seniors and the disabled healthy, active, self-reliant and able to live in their own homes or independently as long as possible.

Fun and friendship at Rendezvous Pointe includes Wii bowling leagues, cards, billiards, movies, raffles, monthly tea parties, and much more. Our annual craft fair and pie social are fun – and profitable, too.

Behind the Scenes

What makes these familiar scenes possible are grant-writing, grant management, quarterly reports, fundraising, financial management, solving problems and conflicts, managing staff, working with our Board of Trustees, working with state and local government, mastering government regulations, drafting policies ranging from disaster preparedness to elder abuse, and above all maintaining a sense of humor.

What Our Seniors Say

Every year we survey our seniors. It gives them a chance to evaluate our programs, our overall atmosphere, and staff. They can also make suggestions on how to improve Rendezvous Pointe. Over the years clear patterns emerge.

- Ninety-seven percent (97%) rate the noon meal “good to excellent.”
- One hundred percent of seniors rate Rendezvous Pointe “friendly to very friendly.”



- Seventy-nine percent (79%) rated Rendezvous Pointe staff “excellent.”
- On a scale of 1-10 with 10 the best ranking, our seniors rated Rendezvous Pointe 9.4.

Beyond the noon meal, the three most important activities or features that bring seniors to Rendezvous Pointe are: 1) health and social services such as the annual blood draw, flu clinic, the lending closet, foot care, senior services, and blood pressure monitoring; 2) connecting with friends and “it is just a fun place”; and 3) the art program, including arts and crafts, painting and drawing, ceramics, and the Fiber Arts Guild.

Planning Ahead

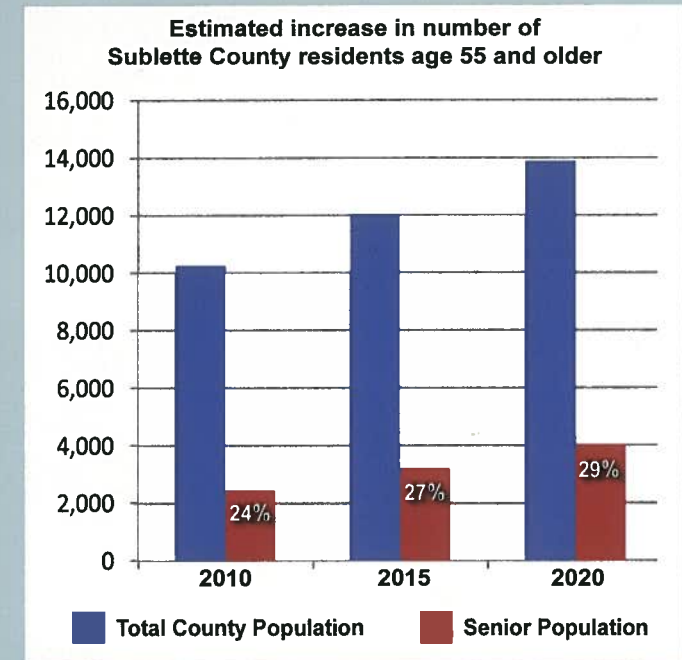
We do plan to “keep up the good work,” and to build on a strong foundation of senior services and financial support to chart a bright future.

Our standard for quality and value is best captured by a 74-year-old Pinedale resident:

Recently, Rendezvous Pointe’s Board of Trustees, working with senior staff, developed and approved a Strategic Plan for 2012-2017. It is our road map for tomorrow.

This plan is designed to meet the needs of a growing senior population, including a sizable number of younger seniors. As the county and state population ages, and life expectancy increases, the demand for Rendezvous Pointe’s services will grow. A premium will be placed on preventive health care, including exercise, in-home services, friendship, and activities to keep



minds sharp. With these services and others, together with an updated building and environs, Rendezvous Pointe will meet these challenges and help our seniors age joyfully.
